

《亞洲廢除死刑策略研討會》

20230526採訪通知

來自法國的共同反死刑組織(Ensemble Contre la Peine de Mort, ECPM)、和台灣廢除死刑推動聯盟以及亞洲反死刑網絡(Anti-Death Penalty Asia Network, ADPAN)將於2023年5月26日至27日在福華國際文教會館舉辦《亞洲廢除死刑策略研討會》,總計有來自歐洲及亞太地區14個國家超過80人與會。

ECPM作為全球廢除死刑運動的重要領頭羊之一,推廣廢除死刑已超過22年,也是每三年一次的世界反死刑大會的主辦團體,去年(2022)在德國柏林舉行第八屆大會,台灣也參與其中。儘管全球有超過三分之二的國家已在法律或實務上廢除死刑,但亞洲一直以來都是全球死刑執行人數最多的區域,2006年成立的亞洲反死刑網絡則是希望整合及連結區域的運動組織,早日讓亞洲可以成為一個沒有死刑的地方。因此,本會議目標是提供亞洲各國廢死工作者深入交流的機會、探討廢除死刑的策略。

5月26日的《亞洲廢除死刑策略研討會》開幕式,除了主辦單位外,也將邀請行政院羅秉成政務委員、國家人權委員會王榮璋副主委、立法委員邱顯智等貴賓致詞,台灣的死刑冤案平反者蘇建和也以自身經歷鼓舞其他廢死工作者。為期兩天的會議,有來自國家人權機構、NGO代表、法律專家、以及前死囚等各界人士參與,將針對亞洲廢死之路,集思廣益各種挑戰和機會。

Opening Ceremony of the Regional Asian Seminar Abolition of the Death Penalty in Asia: What are the strategies at hand? Press Invitation

Together Against the Death Penalty (ECPM), Taiwan Alliance to End the Death Penalty (TAEDP), and the Anti-Death Penalty Asia Network (ADPAN) will host the "Abolition of the Death Penalty in Asia: What are the strategies at hand?" seminar at the Howard Civil Service International House from May 26th to 27th, 2023. The seminar will gather over 80 participants from 14 countries in Europe and the Asia-Pacific region.

ECPM, as one of the leading global abolitionist organizations, has been promoting the abolition of the death penalty for over 22 years. They are also the organizing body of the World Congress Against the Death Penalty, held every three years, with the 8th congress taking place in Berlin, Germany last year (2022), in which Taiwan also participated. Despite more than two-thirds of countries worldwide having abolished the death penalty in law or practice, Asia has remained the region with the highest number of executions. ADPAN, established in 2006, aims to integrate and connect regional abolitionist organisations to make Asia a deathpenalty free zone. Therefore, this seminar provides a platform for in-depth exchanges among abolitionists from various Asian countries and to explore strategies.

Minister without Portfolio Luo Bing-cheng, Vice Chairperson of the National Human Rights Commission, Taiwan Wang Jung-chang, and legislator Chiu Hsien-Chih, a victim of wrongful conviction in Taiwan, will speak at the Opening Ceremony on May 26th. Su Chien-ho, a victim of wrongful execution in Taiwan, will also share his personal experience to inspire other participants. The two-day seminar will engage national human rights institutions, NGOs, legal experts, and former death row inmates, to discuss the challenges and opportunities on the path to abolition of the death penalty in Asia.
