

# Dilapidated and poorly maintained detention facilities and prisons

(dirt, humidity, lack of insulation and light in cells) have a negative impact on the health of prisoners, who suffer from infections and illnesses (asthma, dermatitis, etc.).

Access to water and hygiene is restricted; health care and food are of poor quality.
